BUILDING UPDATE

Shuswap Theatre Society has been in existence since 1978, but there was an active theatrical group in Salmon Arm for many years previous to that. In 1980 the Society purchased an auto body repair shop and converted it into a live playhouse with the society members doing most of the physical work. The building has served adequately over the years, but lacks certain amenities that most theatres have and it is now showing its age. This has prompted the Society to look into building a new and modern facility that will satisfy the needs of Shuswap Theatre Society and arts community for the next 40-50 years. In 2007 a building committee was struck to look into possible building sites, a management model and funding sources. This committee has been meeting every two weeks and has looked at a total of 13 potential sites and reviewed several management models. One such model would include a partnership with the local college and join in its efforts to establish a "College Town" in Salmon Arm. The Theatre Society has three main criteria for their participation in the construction of a new facility. One, they must have a "club room" to conduct theatre business. Two, they must have unrestricted access to the "black box" rehearsal stage. Three, they must have priority booking for the Main Stage shows produced each year. The Society has preliminary floor plans and would like to start fund raising for the new building as soon as a site is selected.

Improv is a form of theatre in which the improvisation actors or improvisers use 'in the moment' acting techniques to perform spontaneously and are often quite comedic. Many improvisational actors/improvisers are also scripted actors and improv techniques teach them the basic skills of listening, clarity, confidence and performing instinctively and spontaneously.

For those of you who are interested in checking out the Improv group, please drop in any time they are practising. Improv meets the first and third Monday of each month (with the exception of Monday, January 3) and all of their practises for the next five months will take place at Shuswap Theatre (either on stage or in the Green Room depending on the needs of the current production).
