Theatre Lighting and Sound

A theatre technician approved by Shuswap Theatre must be hired and present for all rehearsals and performances where the sound and lighting equipment is used. Fees are arranged between the renter and the Shuswap Theatre Technician. If the renter has its own qualified technician, check with the Rentals Manager for approval.

Supporting Local Artists

In an effort to support local musicians trying to establish themselves, Shuswap Theatre is open to negotiating a reduced rate for performances plus a share of ticket sales. This may help to reduce risk in case of a small house but greater revenue should the show be successful.

All rentals require a \$250 damage deposit (cheque) which is refundable if everything is left clean and in good condition.
