House Tech Director Report - Ann

Ann will likely move on purchasing the used syc lights as previously authorized. Will likely need only four of the 7 available units. There may be opportunities coming up to get better main speakers to replace the current ones.

Unused Ducting over the Stage: There has been a plan for some time to remove the unused furnace ductwork over the stage. There is some question whether Steve Genn of Proair will want to reroute any duct work as part of future HVAC improvement plans.

Action: Peter to talk to Steve Genn re: if he plans ducting changes in the house, with reference to the ducts over the stage. If not we can proceed with removing the unused ducting.
