# **New Membership Policy**

Shuswap Theatre has moved to a policy of a fixed annual renewal date for memberships. All memberships will expire on September 30th of each year. (If you just renewed in the last six months, we will extend your membership to September 30, 2012.) New members who join after March 31st 2011 will have their membership extended for the remainder of this year until September 30th of next year. This applies to new members only. ## Building Committee Report by Jake Jacobson, Chair

The Building Committee has been actively pursuing a site for the new theatre project. At this point we are in a holding pattern waiting for the ice to break on one of the sites. The first choice, the old JL Jackson site, has been offered to the CSRD. They will decide whether or not to exercise their option later in the fall. If they don't, we are planning to again approach the School District to see if we can build there.

The second option is a parcel of the same property now slated for low income housing. If no one steps forward and takes on that project, the land may be available to us for use. Both of these sites would put us in close proximity to the possible location of the new and expanded campus of Okanagan College. The advantage of being close to them is the possibility that they may start a theatre arts program and use the new facility.

The third option, staying were we are and buying out Bart's Muffler property, comes at a much higher cost. The location is ideal, but the cost and need to provide additional parking has reduced the status of this option.

A fourth option, the parcel of city-owned land next to Mino's, is still a possibility if the city will release it for use and the theatre membership wants to locate out of the downtown core.

So we must wait until our options either present themselves, or are taken off the playing field. As soon as we have a confirmed site, we can have our floor plans engineered and start fund raising. Hopefully, we will have a direction in a few more months.
