Shuswap Theatre gratefully acknowledges the support of the City of Salmon Arm with a recent grant of \$2500 to purchase new blacks. Stage Blacks are made of a heavy, fire retardant material in accordance with National and BC Fire codes. They are also an unusual size - so the construction makes them even more expensive. 
